12 MAX

Ensure you bring a maximum of:
10 players, 1 coach, 1 scorer

NO SPECTATORS ARE PERMITTED IN THE VENUES

CLUB COVID OFFICERS/SCREENERS ARE PERMITTED TO WAIT IN RECEPTION



COVID OFFICER

Appoint a COVID officer for your club or team and inform the centre who this is. Follow Basketball England and England Netball guidelines for their roles & maintain records of who has played for 21 days.

The centres also have appointed COVID officers – details at the centre.



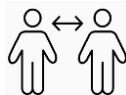
Do not attend the venue if you have a high temperature, a new continuous cough, a loss/change of smell or taste, or if you are otherwise required to self-isolate.

If you develop COVID symptoms within 48 hours of attending the centre, contact NHS test and trace and notify the centre COVID officer.



20 MINS

Arrive 20 minutes before your scheduled game time. Teams will be admitted shortly before scheduled game times. Late arrivals will not be admitted.



2M DISTANCE

Maintain 2m social distancing in and out the venue from people not in your household. Queue and wait to be admitted to the venue.



37.8°C ↓

Our staff will wear a visor and a mask whilst using a contactless forehead thermometer to check your temperature. Anyone with a temperature of 37.8°C or higher will not be admitted and should return home and contact NHS on 119 to organise a COVID-19 test.



If you or someone you live with is pregnant or has underlying medical conditions, notify the centre COVID office and seek advice from a GP to make an informed decision before playing.



Face masks or coverings must be worn by non-players inside the venues at all times, unless you are exempt. Please notify the centre in advance of exemptions.



Come dressed ready to play. Changing facilities will not be generally available. Bibs will not be supplied so ensure your team has a uniform to wear.



Sanitisers will be available for use at the entrance to each building and on each court. Teams and individuals should also bring their own supplies. Sanitise hands on entry to the building and at half time of your game.



Players, coaches & officials should refrain from shouting during games.



Netballs and basketballs will be disinfected before use and at half time of games. After each game, the venue will be cleared and cleaned before the next teams are admitted. Ensure you do not leave litter or lost property.
