## COVID-19 SAFETY MEASURES FOR MATCHES (OUTDOORS)



**12 MAX**

Ensure you bring a maximum of:  
10 players, 1 coach, 1 scorer

**NO SPECTATORS ARE PERMITTED ON OR AROUND THE COURTS**  
CLUB COVID OFFICERS/SCREENERS ARE PERMITTED TO ATTEND



**COVID OFFICER**

Appoint a COVID officer for your club or team and inform the centre who this is. Follow Basketball England and England Netball guidelines for their roles & maintain records of who has played for 21 days. The centres also have appointed COVID officers – details at the centre.



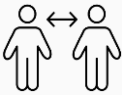
Do not attend the venue if you have a high temperature, a new continuous cough, a loss/change of smell or taste, or if you are otherwise required to self-isolate.

**If you develop COVID symptoms within 48 hours of attending the centre, book a COVID test and notify the centre COVID officer.**



**15 MINS**

Arrive 15 minutes before your scheduled game time. Teams will be admitted shortly before scheduled game times. Late arrivals will not be admitted.



**2M DISTANCE**

Maintain 2m social distancing in and out the venue from people not in your household. Queue and wait to be admitted to the venue. Team members should be socially distanced from each other off the court.



**37.8°C ↓**

**FOR BASKETBALL ACTIVITIES ONLY**

Our staff will wear a visor and a mask whilst using a contactless forehead thermometer to check your temperature. Anyone with a temperature of 37.8°C or higher will not be permitted to play and should return home to organise a COVID-19 test.



Ensure your team has completed the pre-match team screening forms before entering the courts – these are available to download from [www.sportforallcentres.co.uk/covid-19](http://www.sportforallcentres.co.uk/covid-19). Anyone answering 'yes' to any of these questions should not be permitted to play.



If you or someone you live with is pregnant or has underlying medical conditions, notify the centre COVID officer and seek advice from a GP to make an informed decision before playing.



Face masks or coverings must be worn when going indoors for any reason unless you are exempt. Please notify the centre in advance of exemptions.



Come dressed ready to play. Changing facilities will not be generally available. Bibs will not be supplied so ensure your team has a uniform to wear. Do not share or swap bibs between players.



Sanitisers will be available for use at each venue. Teams and individuals should also bring their own supplies. Sanitise your hands on entry to the venue, between periods of play of play, on substituting players, during timeouts (basketball), and once the game has finished.



Players, coaches & officials should refrain from shouting during games.



Netballs, basketballs and netball posts will be disinfected before use, during periods of play and during timeouts (basketball). After each game, the venue will be cleared before the next teams are admitted. Ensure you do not leave litter or lost property.
