- RUNNY NOSE
- HEADACHE
- IF OTHERWISE REQUIRED TO SELF-ISOLATE



VISITORS ARE ENCOURAGED TO SCAN IN ON THE NHS QR CODE POSTERS – THESE HELP IDENTIFY VENUE OUTBREAKS AND ARE NOT USED TO TELL PEOPLE TO SELF-ISOLATE



CLUBS/TEAMS ARE ADVISED TO TEMPERATURE CHECK & SCREEN THEIR PLAYERS PRIOR TO ENTRY & ENCOURAGE PLAYERS TO TAKE LATERAL FLOW TESTS TWICE A WEEK.

WEARING OF FACE MASKS IN VENUES IS EXPECTED AS FOLLOWS:

SANITISE HANDS BEFORE AND AFTER EACH ACTIVITY, AND DURING PERIODS OF PLAY



STAFF AND OFFICIALS WILL REGULARLY DISINFECT:

- MATCH BALLS BETWEEN ACTIVITIES & PERIODS OF PLAY
- NETBALL POSTS
- TOUCH POINTS AND SURFACES THROUGHOUT THE VENUES



IF YOU OR SOMEONE YOU LIVE WITH IS PREGNANT OR HAS UNDERLYING MEDICAL CONDITIONS, NOTIFY THE CENTRE COVID OFFICER AND SEEK ADVICE FROM A GP TO MAKE AN INFORMED DECISION BEFORE PLAYING.



AVOID CONGREGATING IN FOYERS AND CORRIDORS WE ADVISE SOCIALLY DISTANCING OFF COURT



COME READY CHANGED TO PLAY AND AVOID SWAPPING OF BIBS – USE PATCHES OR SPARES FOR NETBALL IF POSSIBLE
